Please make sure the address you give exactly matches the address where your credit card bill goes to.
- 5) Your school supplies will be delivered directly to your school, ready for your child when they arrive at school the first day.
- 6) The deadline to complete your order online without penalty is **June 15**. Online ordering will still be available after the deadline (until August 1st) but may be subject to a \$10.00 late fees.
