- 4) PayPal will ask you for a shipping address –although your school supplies will be delivered directly to your school, this is one of the verification process PayPal uses when you pay with a credit card. Please make sure the address you give exactly matches the address where your credit card bill goes to.
- 5) Your school supplies will be delivered directly to your school, ready for your child when they arrive at school the first day.
- 6) The deadline to complete your order online without penalty is June 15.
Online ordering will still be available after the deadline (until August 1st) but may be subject to a \$10.00 late fees.

THIS IS A VOLUNTARY PROGRAM but one that we are sure will be of value to you and your school as it ensures that students will be provided with quality school supplies that meet the school's exact needs. The supplies will be packaged and delivered directly to your school in August before school starts.
