Due to limited space, parking at ICES is a challenge in the best of times. In light of this, we ask all parents to please follow these guidelines:

- Only staff and EEP parents should be parking in the parking lot to the west of the school. The reason this “luxury” is afforded to EEP parents is that they are required to walk their child to the classroom door and sign their child in. EEP parents often have other small children in their care as well so we want to be sensitive to their needs. This parking lot is NOT supervised, so students without parents in the area becomes a safety concern.
- All other student pick-up and drop-offs should be done along 21 A street North (east of the school). While this is more challenging in cold weather, your child will be OK walking to that door if they are wearing proper winter clothing. Both the ICES administration and the ICS Society office have contacted the city about upgrading that street as a higher priority route due to the fact it is used for student drop off / pick up.
- Parents/visitors that would like to park in front of the school need to remember they can't park in the bus lane in front of school before 9am or after 2:30pm as this interrupts our bus drivers' ability to drop off and pick up students. Even during the day parents are asked not to park directly in front of the school sign as we often have buses using that area for student pick up for field trips.

Unfortunately, these guidelines do not guarantee a lack of challenge for all people, but this will certainly help keep areas as clear as possible and more importantly help promote student safety. We appreciate any grace that can be extended to us and we will try to do the same.

Finally, on a related note, parents are asked to fill out the ICES expansion survey if they have not already done so as parking is one of the things an expansion would hope to address. Expansion link will be posted in the message part of the parent email.
