Step 1: Register

- If you have not registered, please go to the *School Cash Online* home page <https://lethbridge.schoolcashionline.com/> and select the "Get Started Today" option.
- Complete each of the three Registration Steps
*For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.



Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and *School Cash Online* account. The confirmation link will open the *School Cash Online* site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.



Step 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- Enter the School Board Name.
- Enter the School Name.
- Enter Your Child's Student Number (this can be found on the report card)
- Enter Your Child's Last Name and Birth Date.
- Select *Continue*.
- On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select *Continue*.
- Your child has been added to your account.

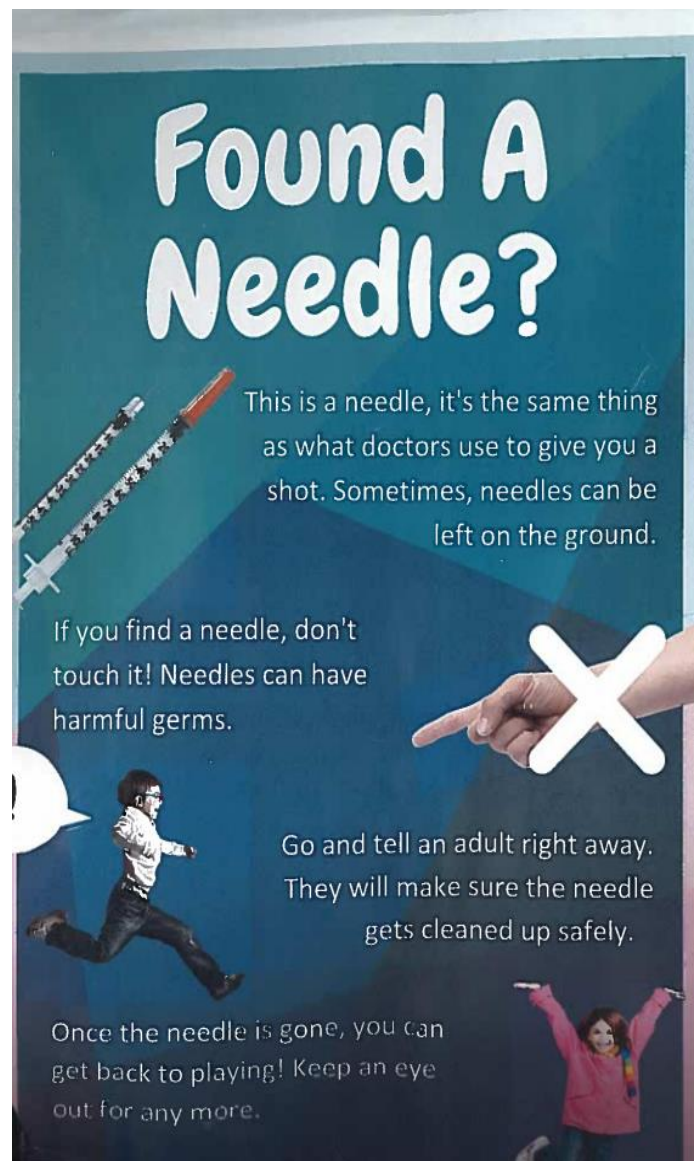

This notice is to share with parents the steps ICES has taken to help ensure safety on the playground.

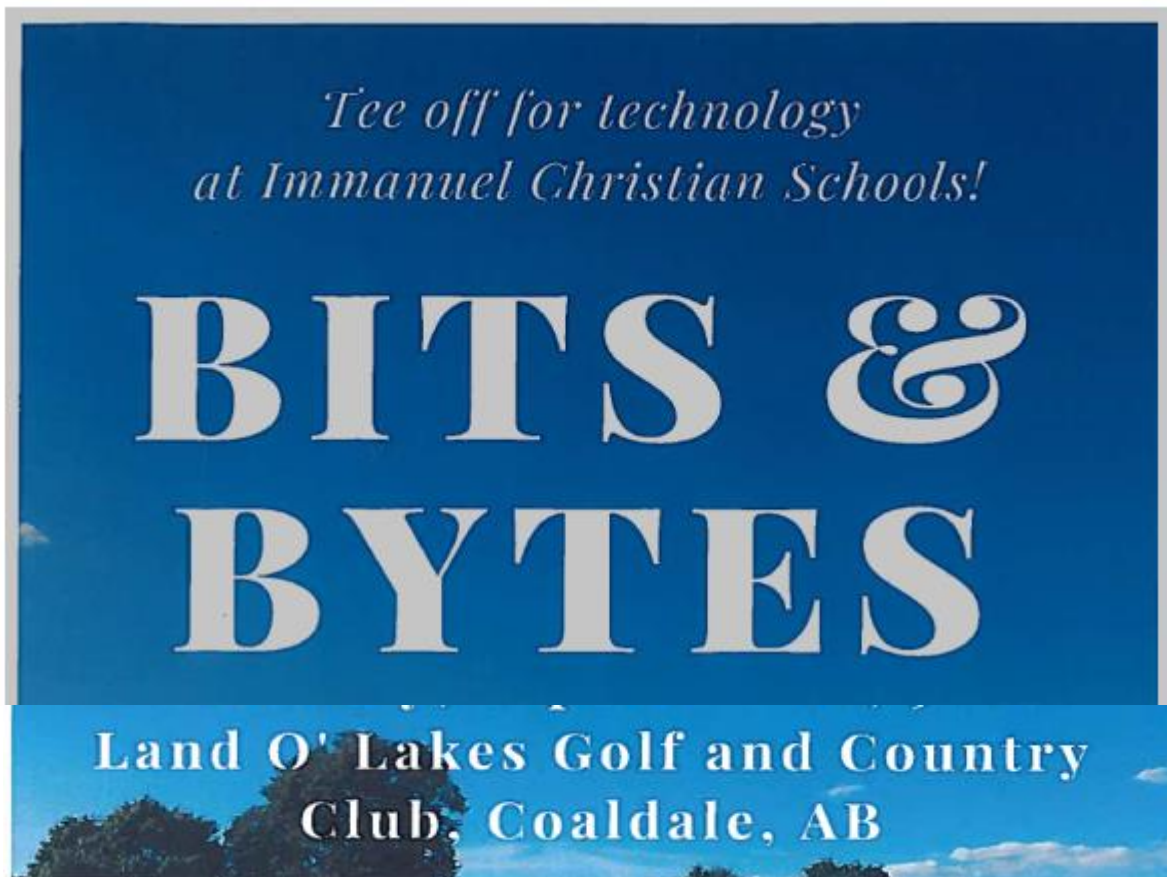
- Staff supervisors will wear vests (bright yellow or orange). Should a student need help they will know where to go.
- A gate was installed between the staff parking lot and the playground. This is to reduce unwanted foot traffic coming through our playground during the school day.
- Before every school day, our custodian does a sweep around the school and will take care of any materials that do not belong there. The playground is vast, and while staff are always on the lookout for non-school related objects; we are unable to cover everything. If parents notice something on our playground that shouldn't be there, you can either let the ICES staff know or (if you feel comfortable) dispose of it yourself.
- Students are regularly reminded of the importance of not touching unidentified things on the playground (please also do this at home).
