LEARNING COMMONS/LIBRARY NOTES

Welcome to another exciting year in the learning commons. Classes have had a chance to visit the learning commons and it was wonderful to meet the new students and see all the returning students again. We’re looking forward to a great year!

This year, we will be doing the Accelerated Reader Program again for students in grades 2 – 5. Accelerated Reader is a program that encourages students to read a book of their choice, at their reading level and then do a short comprehension test. This program has proven to be a successful tool in encouraging students to read more and improve their reading skills. They also have the opportunity to win individual and class prizes for the number of books read!

The following is the ICES learning commons schedule:

Tuesday: Gr. 2B, 2C, 5A & 5B
Wednesday: Gr. KA, 4A, 4B & 1B
Thursday: Gr. KB, 1A, 2A, 3A & 3B
Friday: Gr. 4C

Kindergarten students are allowed to take out 1 books, they must bring it back in 1 week to be able to take out a new book.

Grades 1 & 2 may take out 2 books for 1 week and they must be returned to be able take out new books.

Grade 3 – may take out 3 books and they may now keep their books for 2 weeks.

Grades 4 & 5 – may take out 4 books for 2 weeks.

Again, this year, a book bag is provided to each student to use for this school year. The book bags are orange this year and have the student’s name on it. These bags are used to transport the books to and from school and to protect them from damage, backpack spills etc. Please encourage your children to use their bags. If students lose their bag, they can get a new one for 50 cents. If bags are damaged or worn out, it will be replaced for free. If they do not have their bag at the library, they cannot sign out books. Thank you for your support in this matter.

NOTE: Please keep library books in a safe place in their bag at home away from pets and small children. The library has acid free tape and glue used to repair books and we ask that if a book is damaged due to wear and tear that you not repair it at home, but simply return it to the library with a note and we will take care of the repairs. If books are lost, the books must be paid for.
