
1. Open the internet browser on your computer.
2. Go to our school webpage and click on the PowerSchool link; or type <http://ps.lethsd.ab.ca/public> into the address bar.
3. Click on Create Account --> Create Account.
4. Enter the applicable information ensuring you type your case sensitive Access ID and Access Password exactly as they are printed below. You and [REDACTED] have separate passwords. It is advisable that you keep your username and password secure and not share it with anyone else.
5. View the information.
6. Remember to log off when you are finished.
