ROCK YOUR MOCS – November 15

Rock Your Mocs is a nation-wide day of recognition, awareness, and appreciation for traditional Indigenous culture, specifically, traditional footwear – moccasins. Are slippers the same thing as moccasins? No, they are not. Presently, people do wear moccasins as slippers but traditionally moccasins were always worn as indoor and outdoor shoes. Moccasins were worn to protect peoples' feet from the land and keep them warm and/or dry.

What if I don't have moccasins to wear on November 15? No problem! You don't have to go and buy moccasins in order to help celebrate Rock Your Mocs. We will be doing a few activities that day to learn about the importance of moccasins to Indigenous culture and discussing how we as Image Bearers of God, are called to love and respect all people and all cultures.
