On May 15th, the ICES School Council will have it's final meeting of the school year in-person. This month, the Grade 3 teachers will be sharing their *Deep Hope*, *Storyline* and *TFT* pieces for those attending. Given that we meet in-person, there will be treats and beverages as well!

TFT WONDER FULL TIME

For our third Wonder Full time we let our imaginations run wild through the power of story. Mr. Greeno and I selected 4 picture books, took out all of the words, jumbled the order of all the pictures, and then had the students examine the pictures. After examining the pictures, the students worked in small groups to put in new words to the story. They did this one picture at a time without any other knowledge of the story. Once all the pictures had been rewritten, we put the pages back in their original order to see the story that we were able to create. We have printed a copy of our books for each class so that all the students can see the collective imagination of our school brought together.

For our final Wonder Full time we wanted to take a look at having fun, what the Bible says about having fun and being joyful, and how different groups around the world

have fun together as community. We did this through the learning a few different board games from around the world. We started with Lulu which is a game that originates from Hawaii. In this game each player has 4 two sided tokens that they throw and add up the total they achieve in 2 throws. We were able to use Mr. Riewe's 3-D printer to print a set of tokens for each student to take home. The second game Shisima which is a game strategy game that originates from Kenya. Shisima uses an Octagon shaped board in which a player moves their pieces to try get all 3 pieces in a straight line.
