SCHOOL SUPPLY SURVEY

We are hoping for parent/guardian input to be able to gauge the success and value of the school purchasing the school supplies for all students this year. We took on this pilot program in an effort to maximize the purchasing power we have through the school division as well as to try to help utilize the amount of time our families have. Being the first time, we have done this program there has been a steep learning curve for all involved.

Our school team has observed a few different benefits and a few draw backs. A few benefits to this program including cost savings through bulk purchasing, standardization of supplies so all students have the exact supplies they need when they need it, and moving forward, we should be able to have further cost savings as some supplies such as rulers and scissors will not need to be purchased every year. We also understand that there have been some drawbacks with the program including there are many families that enjoy the tradition of school supply shopping, that some families were a bit confused by what they needed to purchase for the start of the school year, as well as that just like we hope to reuse items every year there are many families that planned on doing the same.

We would like our community as a whole to provide some input so we can continue to evaluate the success and drawbacks that you have had going through the process so that we can assess the viability of the program and proceed in the best way possible.
