COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

Grade One has kicked off their Feed the Hungry FLEX project! This project will run until Oct 11th. This will enable us to collect lots of healthy and delicious food in time for Thanksgiving. We discussed why we are collecting food and highlighted that there are people in our own community who are hungry and that God calls us in the Bible to feed the hungry. This activity will be a great way for Grade 1 to see and participate in God's Story.
