## Learning Commons Notes

Hope everyone had a wonderful summer break and is refreshed and ready to start another school year. We are looking forward to another great year in the Learning Commons – exploring new books and interests as well as engaging in learning activities to help us understand who we are in God's story!

The following is the ICES Learning Commons schedule:

Monday:	Gr. 3A
Tuesday:	Gr. 4A, 5A, & 5B
Wednesday:	Gr. KA, 1A, & 4B
Thursday:	Gr. KB, 3B
Friday:	Gr. 2A & 2B

Kindergarten students may take out 1 book, they must bring it back in 1 week to be able to take out a new book.

Grades 1 & 2 may take out 2 books for 1 week and they must be returned to be able take out new books.

Grades 3 & 4 – may take out a total of 3 books and they may now keep their books for 2 weeks.

Grade 5 – may take out a total of 3 books for 2 weeks.

A red book bag is provided to each student to use for this school year. The book bags have the student's name, class and day they attend Learning Commons on it. These bags are used to transport the books to and from school. They help to protect the books from damage, backpack spills etc. Please encourage your children to use their bags. If students lose their bag, they can get a new one for 50 cents. If bags are damaged or worn out, it will be replaced for free. If students do not have their bag at the learning commons, they cannot sign out books. Thank you for your support in this matter.

**NOTE:** Please keep books in a safe place in their bag at home away from pets and small children. The library has acid free tape and glue used to repair books and we ask that if a book is damaged, that you NOT repair it at home, but simply return it to the learning commons with a note and we will take care of the repairs. If books are lost, the books must be paid for by the end of the school year.
